OUR STUDENTS AND US

Bench Mark exists to build the leader within all underserved youth. We operate the following three programs to accomplish this goal.

OPEN GYM

This voluntary program accepts high school aged students and continues to work with those students for as long as is necessary. Mentors are paired with students and tasked with discovering what needs Bench Mark can meet in their lives. A gym atmosphere is used as the setting for relationship building. In this setting mentors can pinpoint latent leadership within each student. Our goal is to operate at a one to one student to staff ratio.

STRENGTH-BASED SKILL BUILDING (SBSB)

SBSB operates for young men mandated to join through the court system. Utilizing a life skills curriculum, mentors work one on one and in small groups to set and achieve goals.

STUDENT LEADERSHIP PROGRAM (SLP)

The purpose of SLP is to recruit students from the other two programs and give a practical outlet to their newly uncovered leadership potential. These students are hired and compensated to take on responsibilities as mentors to younger students in the other two programs.
